Our annual Missionary Communication Workshop is just around the corner. The dates this year are November 1-6. We have the workshop at a Camp Pondo because they look at our workshop as a ministry to missionaries, and they want to be a part of it. For 10 years now, they have allowed us to use their facility free of charge, but the camp has just informed me that because of the COVID restrictions they cannot provide the financial help this year. That is the bad news, but the good news is that because of the special missions offering of \$6,909 you gave us, we can pay for the expenses of the workshop this year. Praise the Lord!

God blessed us with a three-bedroom house when we moved to Canton, Ohio. When we purchased the house, it was our goal to use the extra bedrooms to house missionaries with whom we were working. Missionaries have been staying with us since we bought the house, but the house needed a lot of work. We have painted the outside of the house and most of the inside rooms. We have replaced heaters, carpeting and tile. This month we were able to finish the last of the major projects. A house built in 1952 does not have the electrical power or the protection needed for today's world. It will be a blessing to the missionaries staying with us this month not to have breakers tripping all the time, and they will now have access to grounded receptacles and surge protection for their computers. These projects were made possible because the money you gave us at the mission conference last year.
