As the coronavirus pandemic eased-up, the new "pandemic" exploded – a WAR! I am sharing about what is happening right behind our own borders and backyards – the lives of innocent people taken grows by every hour as the Russia-Ukraine conflict continues, our God-given Call of spiritual battles engulfs a new dimension.

Our plan of response

- Converting most of our church space into "refugee camp". This involves altering some of our office space, hallways, and storages into living quarters. In some cases, we had to install new or re-configure existing heating, plumbing, showers, kitchenettes.
- Providing long-term accommodation and other existential needs including food to 21 souls (four of them are residing in a church member's home).
- Sharing the Gospel on a personal level. Although most of these refugees come from non-Christian backgrounds, they are very receptive and appreciative. Their testimonies and expressions of gratitude for love they are receiving leave no dry eye in the room.
- We continue to strive to support and provide our local church members and victims of the war with sustaining existential needs and spiritual resources as this unknown conflict continues. Please pray for guidance and wisdom in navigating during these sensitive times. We are blessed beyond measure with your continued support and please do note that you are changing lives and helping those in need.
- Raising additional funds for these unanticipated ministry expenses.
