2024 PRAYER FOCUS: SALT & LIGHT

"Be very careful, then, how you live — not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. Therefore, do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is" (Ephesians 5:15-17).

Paul gives powerful instructions. Be careful how you live! Be wise! Make the most of every opportunity! Don't be foolish! Understand what the Lord's will is! It is an invitation to total dependence on the Lord because the days are evil.

This month we focus on seeking greater dependence on God. It is not just about depending on Him for our daily needs or for his leading in ministry but depending on Him in every aspect of our lives because the days are evil. There is an enemy who seeks to destroy not only the work of God in the planting of churches and making disciples, but also the work Christ has done in each of us. His desire is to mar the image of Jesus in each of us.

He wants us to live as foolish people, to overlook opportunities to represent Jesus, to not recognize the evil of our day, and to miss God's perfect will.

Walking as children of light or walking as Jesus walked requires that we are focused on seeking Jesus, becoming more and more like Him and recognizing that apart from Him we can do nothing. It is about becoming dependent on Him for who we are becoming as much as we depend on Him for what we do.

MARCH PRAYER FOCUS — SEEKING GREATER DEPENDENCE ON GOD

We are changing the format this year. Instead of a daily scripture and prayer, we want to focus on a different region of the Missionary Church each week and a different department at Bethel University. We also want to challenge everyone to look at the theme of the month and ask each week what the Lord wants to say to us.

WEEK #1

PERSONAL REFLECTION — **FIRM STEPS:** "The LORD makes firm the steps of the one who delights in him; though he may stumble, he will not fall, for the LORD upholds him with his hand" (Psalm 37:23-24).
