From our Seminary Session:

“When you asked us to make a long-term commitment to not just study, but to an in-depth learning of God’s word, I was skeptical. I am glad I made the commitment! In the two sessions I’ve been a part of, I have learned how not just read God’s word, but how not to interpret it into my own understanding. I feel that is a big mistake we make as lay pastors. Being able to learn to prepare a sermon has been a huge help to me.”

The second seminar session started with the addition of several new students. It meant that we had to do a quick recap to bring the new students up to date so we could introduce the new information. It was exciting to watch all the students so immersed in their studies. In group projects, I was thoroughly impressed to watch everyone dive into their Bibles to decipher their verses. During their sharing time, they were able to not only show that they understood what they have just learned, but that they were able to share a greater understanding of their material. I spoke with a few of the pastors and was happy to hear their excitement about how much more God’s Word opened to them. They were enthusiastic about being able to prepare a more in-depth sermon for their congregations. I am looking forward to our next seminar session, in July.



From our Free Medical Outreach:

"I walked for three hours, just to get to my nearest road. I then waited another two hours or so to get picked up. I rode in the back for a truck with a few sheep and a pig. (giggles) There were others riding with me. I didn't feel well, and heard of the free clinic, so I wanted to get myself checked. I apparently have a very bad infection. Not only did I get some gifts, but all my medication to fight the infection. I'm glad these doctors came, I'm not sure when I could have gotten to the doctor otherwise."

While talking with Anna Theresa, I thought of her travels. She wasn't very close to the area where we were, but she heard about our free clinic and found a way to get to us. It is hard to think about those who must travel to get to a doctor but also must decide if they can afford the medication, if needed. In the end, it is always a huge blessing for us to see those in need, get the help that they desperately need. Missy was excited to sort and organize all the reading glasses that we had on hand, and that she was able to purchase through a generous gift from our friends at Ventura Jubilee Church. It took Missy and two friends a few days to go through and label all the reading glasses. As we got closer to our clinic dates, we realized that we may not have enough translators, despite having our daughters Shey & Athalia with us. Missy decided to train her friends, Mery & Mari on how to test for reading glasses. Using an example of the glasses chart, she made a sheet using the same measurement, but in Quechua. Between Missy, Mery & Mari, helped close to 375 – 400 people with reading glasses!



Exciting News!!:

This an answer to prayer!! We now have 1,000 Quechua Bibles printed and paid for! Praise God! They are now on their way Peru. Our prayer is that they will be on hand when we arrive to Peru in June - July. Missy and I have been working and praying for this for several years now. Connecting with our friend James and his friend, David has proven to a huge blessing from God! Thank you for keeping this a matter of prayer! God always answers in His time!

- Words cannot express how excited we are hand out the Quechua Bibles, once they arrive to Peru! It is an answer to a 15-year-old prayer!! Praise God! This is the 1987 version, in which my brother Romulo helped to translate.

- **For our physical health:** for Missy as she continues with her physical therapy; for myself as I continue to deal with my unbearable back pain.
- **For Missy, Ruben & I** as we prepare our schedule for our trip to Peru in late May, and return the end of July. There are several things we hope to do, but there never seems to be enough time to do it all.
- **For our Mama Maria**, who remains in good health. It is always wonderful to talk with her on a weekly basis. We give praise for still having her with us.
- **For our daughter Zoyla & her husband Oliver**, they navigate the Immigration system. We are thankful it seems they are 'halfway' done!

We understand these times have been rough, and we know you make great sacrifices to support our ministry. We appreciate your trust in God and decision to support us. We couldn't reach the Indigenous peoples of Peru without friends like you!
