God's Healing Hands at Work in the Andes

We are grateful to report the successful completion of our four-day free medical clinic in the Andes of Ayacucho. Through God's provision and the faithful service of many volunteers, countless lives were touched both physically and spiritually.

Missy and I had the privilege of helping coordinate and set up the clinic alongside a dedicated team of eight volunteer doctors and nurses who traveled from Virginia and Canada to serve in this outreach. Together, the team provided medical care in two remote native Quechua communities, bringing much-needed healthcare to families who otherwise have limited access to medical services.

Throughout the four days, the medical team saw numerous patients with a wide variety of health concerns. Many came seeking treatment for common illnesses such as coughs, colds, and respiratory infections, while others received consultations and care for chronic conditions including diabetes and high blood pressure. Free medications were distributed to patients, providing both immediate relief and ongoing treatment support.

Beyond meeting physical needs, the clinic provided opportunities to minister to the spiritual needs of those who attended. Many individuals and families were overwhelmed by the compassion shown to them. Team members shared the love of Christ, offered encouragement, and prayed with patients who were facing difficult circumstances. Several expressed deep gratitude not only for the medical attention they received but also for the hope and comfort found through prayer.

We praise God for the many lives that were touched and helped through this medical outreach. The clinic was a tremendous success, and we are thankful for every volunteer, supporter, and prayer partner who made it possible.

Please continue to pray for the communities served, that the seeds of faith planted during these days will continue to grow and that God's healing and hope will remain with each family long after the clinic has ended.

The day after the medical team departed Ayacucho, Mari asked to speak with me and Missy about what it means to accept Jesus as her Savior. After a long and heartfelt conversation about faith, salvation, and God's love, I had the privilege of leading Mari in a prayer of salvation.

Despite our often-hetic schedules, it is always a tremendous joy to be available for those who are sincerely seeking God. Please continue to pray for Mari as she begins and continues her journey of faith, that she would grow in her relationship with Christ and remain steadfast in her Christian walk.
